

Clark J. Jacobson Obit

Clark J. Jacobson, 52, of Crookston died very unexpectedly early Tuesday morning, April 13, 1999 at Riverview Hospital.

The funeral service will be held on Saturday at 10:30 a.m. at the Stenshoel-Houske Funeral Chapel, with burial taking place in Calvary Cemetery. Graveside military rites will be held on Friday from 4 to 8 p.m. at the funeral home, with a 7 p.m. prayer service, and also for one hour before the service.

Clark was born on August 7, 1946 in Ada, the son of Chester and Evelyn (Houske) Jacobson.

As a young child, he moved with his family to Hendrum, then to Montana, and to Crookston in 1955. Clark was a 1964 graduate of Crookston Central High School. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Navy. Clark spent two years in Vietnam and, after his discharge, he returned to Crookston.

He married Mary Stanley in Zimmerman, MN on November 11, 1967. The couple made their home in Crookston. Clark worked in construction for many years before returning to school in the early 1980s. He then went to work at Nelson Motors in Crookston, where he was working until the present time.

Clark belonged to the American Legion Post #20, and was a very active member of V.F.W. Post #1902, having served on the Drill Team for many years.

He loved to hunt, fish, do crossword puzzles, play solitaire and spend time with his family.

Survivors including his wife, Mary; two daughters, Christine Bartell, Princeton, MN, and Dawn Jacobson, Crookston; a son, Craig, Austin, MN; three grandchildren; two sisters, Diane Ellingson, Langdon, ND, and Gail Agnes, Valley City, ND; and a brother, Gene, Marion, MT.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
