Michael P. Moore, 51, of Lindstrom, MN, and formerly of Crookston died on Sunday, August 10, 1997 at his home in Lindstrom.

The funeral service was scheduled for today, Friday, at Miller-Bies Funeral Service in Roseville. Burial with military honors will take place at Fort Snelling National Cemetery.
