

Patricia Ann Johnson Obit

Patricia Ann Johnson was killed March 7, 1966 in an automobile accident on Highway 61 in Washington County Minnesota. The crash occurred just after midnight and left seven people dead, including five young people from Forest Lake and a husband and wife from Lindstrom.

Miss Johnson, the daughter of Lloyd and Marie (Grass) Johnson of Forest Lake, was born Nov. 5, 1946, in Grand Rapids, Minn.

She graduated from Central High School in Crookston in 1964.

Miss Johnson had been employed as a clerk at Hart's Rexall Drug.

Survivors, in addition to her parents, include two sisters, Corki, at home, and Mrs Susan(Gary) Swanson, Grand Forks, N.D.; a bother, Kenneth, Stanley, N.D.; her maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Grass, Sioux Falls, S.D.; and paternal grandfather, J.P. Johnson, Crookston.

The funeral service Patricia Ann Johnson will be held Wednesday, March 9, at Church of Christ of Forest Lake, Minn. The Rev. Willard Kelly, pastor, and the Rev. Richard Moorhouse, assistant pastor, officiated.

Burial followed in Cedar Hills cemetery.
